

Steffan Soule's Recycling Rabbit

Reuse scraps of colored paper to create Rosco the Recycling Rabbit! Rosco wants your family and friends to know how important it is to re-use and recycle.

What you'll need:

Picture of Rosco the Recycling Rabbit on 9x12 colored paper

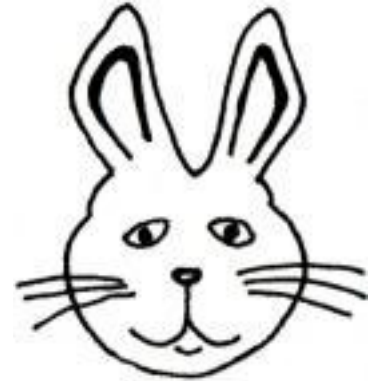
Small scraps of colored paper

Rubber Cement or Glue

Scissors

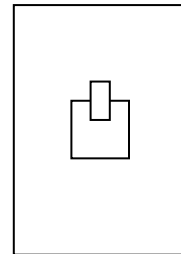
A matching piece of 9x12 colored paper

Tape



Before you perform:

1. Glue the 2 pieces of 9x12 colored paper together in the center being sure the picture of Rosco shows.
2. Cut pieces of colored paper and glue them to the picture of Rosco.
3. Fold the sheet of paper with Rosco on it into a small packet. Fold it tightly so it will stay folded. You may want to tape along one edge to keep it in place. The paper should look like this:



The Performance:

1. Hold the paper up so with the packet facing you. Don't let your friends see the hidden packet.
2. Lay the paper on the table in front of you. Talking about how a magic rabbit named Rosco taught you about the importance of re-using even the smallest pieces of paper.
3. Lay a few scraps of colored paper on the large sheet. Fold the small pieces into a packet that matches the one on the back of the paper. If needed, use a piece of tape to keep the paper folded together.
4. Pick up the packet(s) of paper, holding them as one.
5. As you say the magic words, "Re-use, Recycle and _____" turn the packet over in your hand.
6. Unfold the packet and introduce your friends to Rosco the Recycling Rabbit!
